Cream cheese orders need to be placed with regular lead time Monday through Thursday. Unfortunately we will not be able to support order changes through this allocation. Schreiber will monitor orders to the allotted amounts.



Dear Valued Partners,

As you are well aware, the pandemic and the fallout from it have not eased in the New Year. There continues to be challenges with labor, production, and transportation across our industry. Many suppliers find themselves navigating between the need to produce enough product to meet demand while also providing a safe work environment for their employees. As such, Schreiber Foods has presented IPAP with an update regarding their production challenges and a policy they are implementing in the hopes of addressing those issues.

As one of the largest producers of cream cheese in the U.S., Schreiber has faced a lot of challenges in this category over the last year. Demand for cream cheese has soared and drastically affected their forecasting and operational schedule which has affected customer fill-rates. To help address these matters, Schreiber is implementing an allocation process to provide a consistent stream of product to their customers. This policy will go into effect for orders placed on or after January 24, 2022.
