Please see items listed below that will be short to cover or OOS for the coming months.

Diced Apples	2/5#	15122	534053	OOS Southeast DC (GA) due to delayed inbound - Recovery Mid-March
Diced Strawberries	2/5#	17951	488162	Short to cover Midwest DC (IN) and East (PA) next 2-3 weeks awaiting inbounds
Pineapple Cubes	2/5#	28317	463796	Inbound product subject to ongoing port delays on West Coast
Mango Cubes	2/5#	10550	488161	Product Limited until April at Southeast DC (GA)
Mango Natural Cut	1/10#	10548	725383	Awaiting Spring Crop Out of Stock until May
Strawberry Whole	2/5#	17711	445825	Delayed arrival of Spring crop - Unavailable 2-3 weeks at West Coast DC (CA)

Many of the current shortages are driven by:

- Product quality specification needs not met
- Adverse weather conditions in the growing regions
- Delays in current ocean freight supply chains
- Plant production limits due to ongoing labor constraints

Some Additional Callouts for 2022:

- California strawberry crop production set to increase 10%
- Some frozen fruits are supplied from Ukraine which will place additional strain on the current environment
- Central Valley below normal temperatures could affect peach crop by damaging early blooms

We will continue to update this information on an ongoing monthly basis, however please note that all product availability can be impacted by unforeseen delays in the supply chain.
